

GED PRACTICE TEST INFORMATION

Overview

Many students are not sure about committing to a class but want to see what the GED is like or if they are ready. Taking an official GED practice test is highly recommended before taking the official GED test. Practice testing allows the student to demonstrate GED test readiness. The student completes a timed practice test, exactly half the time of the actual GED test, on the same five subjects of the GED (writing, which includes an essay, social studies, science, reading and mathematics). Test results identify strengths and weaknesses. Instructors provide recommendations for further student action. Students must attend both test sessions to complete the entire battery of tests.

GED TESTING

GED Overview

You are taking a big step toward changing your life with your decision to take the GED test. The GED test covers the same subjects that students study in high school: writing, which includes an essay, social studies, science, reading and mathematics. The five subjects make up the full GED test battery. Testing is provided year-round at various locations.

Special Accommodations

Reasonable accommodations are available upon request to individuals who qualify. Accommodations must be requested before registering for the GED test. To begin the process of requesting accommodations, call 768-6140 or stop in the Adult Continuing Education Office, 10101 Courthouse Road, to pick up and complete the necessary forms. Not all accommodation requests are granted.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years old and not enrolled in public school.
- Must register in person.
- Must preregister online at www.GED123.org and bring in printed verification.
- Must possess and present a valid Virginia DMV license or DMV identification card.
- Social Security card is recommended.

TEST COST

- Must pay at the time of registration.
- \$45 paid with a money order only (all five tests).
- \$7 per test (after taking the entire test once).
