(The color-coded notebooks help your child organize his/her work more easily.)

- 2 boxes crayons - 24 count - **NO GREATER NUMBER**, please
- 4 bottles white school white school glue - **4 oz.**
- 1 pair child's scissors
- 1 zippered pencil case (No pencil boxes)
- 3 black & white composition book
- 4 pocket folders
- 2 black non-toxic, low odor dry-erase markers
- 1 pack of 3 x 5 index cards

These supplies should last the full school year and will be stored for each child in the classroom. With "Back to School" sales, we feel that it would be more economical for you to purchase everything at one time.
